## Iowa Division of Workers' Compensation (IWD DWC) Announcement

### **Trading Partners Transmitting Directly (Direct SFTP) and EDI Vendor Testing for Mandatory Release 3.1 Reporting has begun!**

Date: May 23, 2018

The testing period for IWD DWC Trading Partners (Direct Reporters) and EDI Vendors for testing IAIABC Claims Release 3.1 has started.

The IWD DWC Trading Partner Profile Registration(s) must be completed in order for testing to begin. If you have not yet registered as a Trading Partner, you must register now. IWD DWC requires each entity, including those who plan to use an EDI Vendor, to complete the Electronic Trading Partner Registration. The Trading Partner Registration provides pertinent information to OK WCC about the Sender, Receiver, Insurers, Claim Administrators and transmission protocol. Trading Partners Transmitting Directly (Direct SFTP) and EDI Vendors are required to complete the Test Plan. The IWD DWC Test Plan can be found at <https://iwddwcedi.info/>, select Implementation Info. Trading Partners and/or their EDI Vendors must request testing feedback from Verisk/ISO by submitting the Iowa EDI Testing Feedback Request List R3.1 to [iwddwcedi@iso.com](mailto:iwddwcedi@iso.com).

Exception: No testing is required for IWD DWC Free Web Entry filers.

Please note the following important information regarding the test files coming in:

- Must have proper information, coincident with method approved on Trading Partner Profile
- Test/Production Indicator (DN 0104): Located in position 82 of the Header Record should be set to 'T' for all testing

IWD DWC will return acknowledgments to the Trading Partner during the testing phase(s). Processing is usually done the same day but no longer than 48 hours after the data is submitted with consideration for test file format issues or other unexpected processing issues.

Testing for Mandatory Reporting ends November 21, 2018 and Mandate Date for IWD DWC EDI Claims Release 3.1 is December 3, 2018.
